

# 2010 Section IX Boys Tennis Tournament

1. Top 8 singles and doubles qualifiers from the OCIAA Tournament qualify for Section IX Tournament. Top 8 singles from MHAL Tournament qualify for Section IX Tournament.
2. Date: May 24<sup>th</sup> and May 25<sup>th</sup>  
Rain dates: May 26<sup>th</sup> and May 27<sup>th</sup>  
Start Time: 10am
3. Site: SUNY New Paltz 1 Hawk Drive, New Paltz , NY 12561  
Outdoor Tennis Courts located behind Elting Gym and Athletic and Wellness Center  
Parking is available in lots adjacent to tennis courts.  
Bathrooms are located in the Athletic and Wellness Center.
4. Format:  
**Day 1:** Singles and Doubles matches through the quarterfinals. Best 2 of 3 tie-break sets using no-ad scoring, match tiebreak (first to 10 points) will be played in lieu of the 3<sup>rd</sup> set.  
**Day 2:** Singles and Doubles matches, semifinals, finals, consolations. Best 2 of 3 tiebreak sets using regular scoring.  
\*Doubles will use Coman Tiebreak System at 6 games all in each set during semifinal, final & consolation rounds (this system will be used at the State Tournament)
5. Top 3 singles players and doubles teams qualify for NYSPHSAA State Tournament, June 3 (1pm), June 4 (8am) and June 5 (8am) at the USTA National Tennis Center (US Open), Flushing Meadows, NY.
6. One coach per school is permitted for each match. Parents, teammates, relatives, non-school coaches are not permitted to coach during a player's match. A 3 minute rest is permitted after the first set, a 5 minute rest period is permitted between the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> set. Use a new can of balls for the 3<sup>rd</sup> set.
7. If available, USTA Roving Umpires will be used, Point Penalty System (PPS) will be enforced. School Coaches will assist the enforcement of player and spectator behavior.
8. No jewelry, proper tennis attire, non-marking sneakers are required. Cell phones and other electronic devices must be silent or off when on court. Players and coaches provide their own food and water; please throw away garbage both on court and outside tennis area, as we are guests of the college.
9. There will be an AED onsite; if available, an Athletic Trainer will be onsite; it is the school coach's responsibility to provide any emergency CPR, AED, or First Aid treatment to their student-athlete.

1. **DATES :** Thursday June 3<sup>rd</sup> (1pm)  
Friday June 4<sup>th</sup> (8am)  
Saturday June 5<sup>th</sup> (8am)
2. **SITE :** USTA National Tennis Center, Flushing Meadows, NY
3. **Hotel :** Crowne Plaza La Guardia Hotel, 104-04 Ditmars BLVD. East Elmhurst, NY (near LaGuardia Airport); Phone # (718) 457-6300; there are a limited number of rooms and are held for players and coaches only, if you need a room for your bus driver, schools must reserve on their own and probably at another hotel nearby; all coaches are responsible for the supervision of their player(s) at the hotel and tournament site and a Credit Card Authorization Form is required for coaches to fill out for hotel misc. expenses; if there is damage or theft in any room, schools will be billed accordingly.
4. **Meals:** Each school district is responsible for meal accommodations and meal money throughout the state tournament.
5. **Transportation:** Each school district is responsible for their own transportation to the tournament site and hotel each day of the tournament. It is the coach's responsibility to make sure your players are on time for all matches.
6. **Forms:** The Section IX Chairman must present the original signed "Commitment to Compete": and "Code of Conduct" documents at the seeding meeting on Thursday June 3<sup>rd</sup> at 8am. Please fill out the required forms and return to the Section IX Chairman immediately after the Section IX Tournament has finished. Failure to complete and return these documents will result in the player being ineligible to compete in the state tournament, no exceptions.
7. **Tennis Attire:** All players must wear proper tennis attire, which includes a tennis shirt that is one of the following: school shirt, sectional or state tennis shirt, or a white tennis shirt. Shirts, hats, etc. will be available to purchase by a vendor next to the tournament table. No Jewelry shall be worn during play and non-marking sneakers are required.
8. **Balls:** Tennis balls will be provided for matches when reporting to the tournament desk prior to your match. Ask for a new can of balls if playing a 3<sup>rd</sup> set.
