Eligibility: Every team in Section 9 was invited to participate. This year 25 teams will participate. This is an EXTRA tournament that does **NOT** count toward an Individuals 22 points or their 50% weigh-in rule. The 25 teams entered will wrestle to determine the overall SECTION NINE D1 & D2 dual meet champions. Losers are eliminated.

Seeding: The final bracket sheet is attached. Seeding was based upon the number of teams entered (25). The returning NUMBER OF SECTIONAL POINTS was used as a main criteria. Each of last years sectional qualifiers earned 2 points which was added to the number of points earned in the section tournament by your team last year (not counting graduates). D2 totals are calculated separately. Other factors that were considered were: OCL opponents you were not originally scheduled to wrestle, teams available to host and travel distances.

Entry Fee: The non-host schools must pay for one full official's fee plus an official's travel fee. The OCIAA Athletic Office will bill each school participating for the officials. You do not need to bring a voucher. The host school is responsible for security, personnel, gate, custodians etc. They keep the gate fees received to offset their costs. Section 9 will pick up the cost of DAY #3.

Trophies/Plaques: The top 2 teams will receive a team trophy or plaque. Members of the championship team will receive individual patches as: 2008-09 SECTION NINE DUAL MEET CHAMPS and T-shirts donated by the Friends of Section 9 (if budget permits)..

Weigh-Ins: MONDAY & TUESDAY:

Should an individual dual meet end in a tie, the following criteria will be used to determine the winner:

- 1. TEAM WITH LEAST AMOUNT OF TEAM POINTS PENALIZED FOR FLAGRANT OR UNSPORTSMANLIKE CONDUCT**
- 2. MOST INDIVIDUAL MATCHES WON**
- 3. MOST PINS / TECH FALLS /DEFAULTS / FORFEITS / DQ's**
- 4. MOST SUPERIOR DECISIONS**
- 5. MOST MAJOR DECISIONS**
- 6. MOST FIRST POINTS SCORED**
- 7. GREATEST AMOUNT OF NEARFALL POINTS**
- 8. GREATEST # OF TAKEDOWNS**
- 9. GREATEST # OF REVERSALS**
- 10. GREATEST # OF ESCAPES**
- 11. LEAST AMOUNT OF STALL POINTS**
- 12. LEAST AMOUNT OF STALL WARNINGS**
- 13. LEAST AMOUNT OF POINTS FOR ALL OTHER INFRACTIONS**
