Rationale:

Presently "grade level" status is configured differently throughout the state. There is variability in the methods school districts use to determine grade level status. They could be based on the number of credits earned or could simply be based on cohort status. In addition, given the COVID-19 pandemic and the ability of parents to decline the regents examination exemption, students may end up being retained in a grade level, thereby affecting a district's BEDS numbers. Therefore, using the grade level cohort for classification would provide a uniform method of counting students.

Proposal:

Consideration of approval to remove the merged team requirement from the School of Distinction and School of Excellence applications.

Effective Start Date:

Spring 2021

Rationale:

Currently, if schools have merged teams (despite the school being the host or not), those teams must be listed on the application in order to qualify for either SOD/SOE award. For example, if an ice hockey team is merged with another school, ice hockey must have been recognized for a Scholar-Athlete Team Award, despite the number of students from the non-host school. This has negatively impacted some schools from qualifying for both awards.

Consideration of approval to eliminate “or a private school within that district’s boundaries” from the NYSPHSAA Transfer Rule. See below.

31.b. A student who transfers without a corresponding change in residence of his/her parents (or other persons with whom the student has resided for at least six months prior) is ineligible to participate at the varsity level in any interscholastic athletic contest in a particular sport for a period of one (1) year if as a 9-12 student participated in that sport during the one (1) year period immediately preceding his/her transfer. A student’s period of ineligibility begins with the date of registration at the student’s new school. (May 2020) NOTE: Students in grades 7-10, shall be eligible to participate at the sub-varsity level and practice at all levels, while students in grades 11-12 shall be limited to practice (all levels) only. (July 2019). At no time during the one-year period of ineligibility at the varsity level should a student participate in a scrimmage or be an exhibition participant at the varsity level.

Students who transfer from any school to the public-school district of the residence of his/her parents (or other persons whom the student has resided for at least six months) ~~or a private school within that district’s boundaries~~ shall receive a waiver from the Transfer Rule. Such a transfer without penalty will only be permitted once in a high school career. Schools must submit the required transfer form to the Section office. Athletes are not permitted to practice before the form has been submitted. Athletes are not permitted to compete without approval. NOTE: A student in a foreign exchange program listed by CSJET has a one-year waiver of the Transfer Rule. If such a student elects to stay a second year he/she becomes a foreign student at the start of the school year with item (b) in effect.

Effective Start Date:

2021-2022 School Year

Rationale:

The verbiage creates an unfair advantage for the private school of transfer and public schools without a private school within their boundaries. All other transfers from a public school district to a private school are subject to the transfer rule in any sport a student participated in for one (1) year. As a result of the current language, students can transfer to a private school within their district’s boundaries for athletic purposes for no penalty. This only impacts districts with private school within their boundary and it should be consistent across the state regardless of the location of the private school.

The NYSPHSAA Wrestling Committee is seeking approval to modify the current appeals procedure used in the State Championships (Dual and Individual) with the following changes:

- The Appeals Committee shall be the NYSWOA President, NYSWOA Past President and the NYS Rules Interpreter. The NYSPHSAA Wrestling State Coordinator will oversee the process and participate in the discussion but will not be a voting member.
- If an appeal is filed at the end of a match, only the offended wrestler must remain on the mat, but the mat official shall instruct the other wrestler to remain in the mat area.
- The coach will have two minutes to state his/her case however the Appeals Committee may have additional questions for the coach.
- Waive NFHS rule 3-1-9 to allow the Appeals Committee, at their request only, to review video replay that is supplied only by a NYSPHSAA approved broadcast partner. This would apply only to state semifinals and finals matches only.

February 2021

Due to the closing of Hudson Valley Awards, Goshen, NY it was necessary for Section IX Athletics to find another vendor for its medals and plaques. Section IX was looking for a vendor that would not only be able to handle the medal and plaque order but also become a sponsor and partner with Section IX Athletics.

Crown Awards, located in Hawthorne, NY is who we are recommending to become our Section IX vendor of medals and plaques. Crown Awards is listed as "America's Largest Awards Supplier" and currently supplies NYSPHSAA with medals and plaques.

Section IX would see cost savings ordering medals and plaques from Crown Awards. The savings Section IX would see using Crown Awards for its medals are: Gold Medals \$2.90 per medal and Silver and Bronze Medals \$1.25 per medal. Crown Awards has guaranteed the medals will be the same quality as our current medals with the longer custom ribbon. The cost of the plaques would be the same as we paid Hudson Valley Awards. The reason the medals cost more as delivered by Hudson Valley Awards was because they were the middle man between the manufacturer and the client, Section IX. Section IX needs approximately 2,000 gold and 2,000 silver medals and with Section IX ordering approximately 800 bronze medals per year.

The attached contract favors Section IX in getting a savings for the cost of the medals, \$1,500.00 sponsorship per year and \$250.00 per year in merchandise. I have attached the proposed Agreement with Crown Awards Inc. please review for approval by the Section IX Athletic Council.

NYSPHSAA hereby accepts such engagement from Vendor.

Shipping and Delivery. All Products will be shipped via FedEx Ground 2 - 3 times per year. Expedited shipping or additional shipments will be at Standard FedEx Rates.

Payment Terms. NYSPHSAA IX will receive from Vendor an email confirmation of each order placed and another email of each order shipped. All orders will ship with terms of Net 30.

Taxes. Vendor shall bill NYSPHSAA IX NY State Sales Taxes for all shipments to NY addresses at the applicable rate based on the tax jurisdiction of the “ship to” address. Sales taxes, if any, on all shipments to destinations outside NY State will be the sole responsibility of NYSPHSAA IX. NYSPHSAA IX shall provide any Tax-Exempt certifications.

Force Majeure Neither party shall be in default or liable to the other party for any delay, interruption or failure to perform, due to causes beyond the reasonable control of either party, including, but not limited to, fire, explosion, natural disaster or other casualty, severe weather conditions, catastrophe, act of God, act of the public enemy, war, civil disturbance, acts or imminent threats of terrorism, declaration, act or advisory of any multinational, federal, state, or municipal government, agency or official thereof, government-imposed restrictions, public health emergency or measures responding to the outbreak of infectious disease, pandemic, epidemic, or quarantine, strikes or threat of strikes, freight embargo, default of manufacturer or supplier, labor shortage,

transportation contingencies or curtailments, or any other cause, whether of the kind enumerated or otherwise, regardless of foreseeability, rendering performance inadvisable, commercially, technologically or otherwise impracticable, illegal, or impossible.
