Student-Athlete Mask Toleration:

On September 2, 2021, New York State Department of Health (NYSDOH) released the Interim NYSDOH Guidance For Classroom Instruction in P-12 Schools During the 2021-2022 Academic Year. This guidance mandates that all students, personnel, teachers, administrators, contractors, and visitors must wear masks at all times indoors, regardless of vaccination status. The guidance does not reference a student's ability to determine toleration while engaged in physical activity.

After seeking clarification on the topic, state officials provided the following response:

"DOH's guidance does make some accommodation for indoor sports where masking is not possible, but with the caveat that individuals must be distanced 6 feet apart, but otherwise participants must wear masks. Masking is not required for outdoor sports. Unlike some prior guidance, CDC's most recent masking guidance does not make an exception for school sports/activities where masking may not be "tolerable" to a participant, unless the participant has an ADA recognized disability. In fact, the CDC guidance recommends masking for activities in the same manner as for regular classroom/in school.

Therefore, if individuals are participating in indoor sports and it is not possible for them to wear masks, they must maintain at least 6 feet physical distancing at all times when unmasked. If it is not possible for them to wear masks and not possible to maintain 6 foot distancing at all times, then that individual should not participate in the event. Obviously keep in mind that the CDC currently recommends that high risk-sports in areas with high community spread should not occur unless all participants are fully vaccinated. That is not currently a state requirement, but since CDC recommends canceling these events, taking an abundance of caution so that they can occur is preferred."

Officials As Contractors:

On September 2, 2021, the New York State Department of Health (NYSDOH) released the Commissioner's Determination on COVID-19 Testing Pursuant to 10 NYCRR 2.62. New York State officials have provided clarification that the above referenced determination does apply to interscholastic sports officials, judges, umpires, etc. who work as independent contractors in P-12 school districts.

The September 2nd NYSDOH determination included the following:

"Teachers and Staff. This determination applies to all P-12 (public or non-public) school district faculty or staff, including all teachers, substitute teachers, student teachers, school administrators, paraprofessional staff, and support staff, including bus drivers. This determination also applies to contractors working in a P-12 school (public or non-public) or school district setting, including contracted bus drivers."

Executive Committee Meeting – October 20, 2021

On Monday, September 27th the Section Executive Directors and members of the NYSPHSAA staff met to explore options to lend assistance to school districts to comply with the NYSDOH mandate pertaining to sports officials as contractors. A meeting is being scheduled for early October between Section Executive Directors, NYSPHSAA staff and representatives of all officials' associations. Updates will be provided as information becomes available.

2021-2022 NYSPHSAA State Championships:

At this time, NYSPHSAA plans to host all State Championship events as scheduled. On September 9th, NYSPHSAA released the following Championship Protocol and information pertaining to the 2021-2022 State Championships. It is important for member schools to understand and have knowledge of the protocol that will be utilized if a confirmed positive COVID-19 case impacts a member of their team while participating in post season play.

COVID-19 Protocol

The following protocol will be published in all Championship Operation Packets and utilized for 2021-2022 NYSPHSAA Regional and State Championship events if a participating member school is notified of a confirmed positive COVID-19 case impacting a member of their team (i.e., players, coaches, managers, etc.) during post season play. Championship Operation Packets are released approximately one month prior to the State Championship.

1) When advancing to regional and state championship play, school administration must immediately notify the NYSPHSAA Executive Director of any confirmed COVID-19 positive case or close contact (as defined by the Department of Health) impacting a member of their team.

Any members of a team who have tested positive will not be permitted to participate in NYSPHSAA Regional and/or State Championship events until properly cleared by Department of Health officials and will not be permitted entrance into any Regional or State Championship venue. School administration should follow their approved local Department of Health protocols and develop a contingency plan to properly supervise students if a confirmed COVID-19 case were to originate during a NYSPHSAA Regional and/or State Championship event.

2) NYSPHSAA Executive Director or his designee will immediately notify the appropriate local departments of health.

3) The member school will work in conjunction with their local county department of health to determine if they can continue participating in the NYSPHSAA Regional and/or State Championship. It shall be the responsibility of the member school to inform NYSPHSAA's Executive Director of their ability to continue participating in accordance with the released event schedule. No game dates or times, event schedules, etc. will be adjusted or revised to accommodate an impacted school (i.e., quarantine, contact tracing, etc.).

4) If the member school determines it is unable to continue participating in a NYSPHSAA Regional and/or State Championship event, it shall be the responsibility of the NYSPHSAA Executive Director to

Currently several NYSPHSAA sports have more than 600 teams competing in the NYSPHSAA State Championships. In an effort to provide more equity amongst all NYSPHSAA Championship sports and greater opportunity for students to experience a NYSPHSAA Championship, criteria for a sixth classification is being proposed by the Classification Ad Hoc Committee.

With the proposed format by the Classification Ad Hoc Committee to establish classification cut off numbers of 75 (top) and 100 (bottom) a larger discrepancy exists for the number of teams competing for a NYSPHSAA Championship in the remaining classes when comparing five classes to six classes.

- Sections will notify NYSPHSAA of ANY classification changes (mergers/ demergers, non-publics, new teams, etc.) following Executive Committee approval (October); changes will not impact the classification of another team.
