- i. Jury of Appeals must be set up for all Sectional and State Qualifiers.
- ii. Those on the Jury of Appeals must remain at the competition until the last event has been completed.
- *iii.* Decisions must be made on site and are final. Getting a ruling from the State Interpreter is required.
- iv. When a decision is reached, the Athletic Directors of schools involved must be contacted
- v. Anyone involved in the dispute must recuse themselves.
- vi. Sport Chairperson must notify the State Rules Interpreter of the dates of the Championships.

Information should be stated in the Sports Handbooks.

## 1. Dr. Robert Zayas - Executive Director

- Transgender Student Participation
   NYSPHSAA continues to advise its member schools to place students on teams
   that most appropriately align with students' gender identity.
- b. NYSPHSAA Amateur Rule It is imperative student-athletes and their parents/guardians are aware of the NYSPHSAA Amateur Rule, which prohibits accepting money or other compensation when competing in non-NYSPHSAA sponsored events.
- c. NYSED Mixed Competition
  The New York State Education Department (NYSED) is currently in the process
  of reviewing regulations and guidance related to mixed gender competition in
  athletics teams; it is anticipated regulatory revisions will be presented at an
  upcoming Board of Regents meeting.
- d. Anyone Can Save a Life starts this Fall 2024 All interscholastic teams complete the program within the first two weeks of the season starting with the Fall 2024 season. A copy of the Emergency Action Plan for the team will be submitted to the Athletic Director office by the coach after the completion of the program. Teams would also be required to conduct one (1) emergency drill prior to 50% of the games being played for that team.

## **NYSPHSAA Executive Committee Meeting Recap**

#### May 1, 2024 Executive Committee Approved Items:

(Passed) (A) Consider approval of Debra Ferry as the next NYSPHSAA Officer (September 1, 2024 – August 31, 2032).

Passed (A) Consider approval to waive the NYSPHSAA 7-Day rule for the remainder of the 2024 Spring sports season for all sports.

Passed (A) Consider approval to cancel the 2025 and 2026 Central Committee meeting hotel contracts and secure hotel contracts in Lake Placid (2025) and Buffalo area (2026).

(Passed) (A) Consider approval of the 2024-2025 NYSPHSAA Budget.

(Passed) (A) Consider approval to permanently use the standby official (6th Official) at the semifinal and final games as an on-field working official in the sport of Football.

(Passed) (A) Consider approval to revise the NYSPHSAA Drone Policy to address law enforcement.

(Passed) (A) Consider approval to revise the NYSPHSAA Appeal procedures to address when the committee meets and to clarify the use of video is not permissible.

(Passed) (A) Consider approval to revise the NYSPHSAA Sportsmanship Rule to read, "Spectators and/or anyone involved in interscholastic athletics shall not be permitted to use vulgar/offensive or racially/culturally insensitive language or engage in any racially/culturally insensitive action. NYSPHSAA Sections may sanction, censure or place schools on probation that fail to address derogatory or inappropriate behavior deemed harmful to physical or mental well-being for those involved in interscholastic activities."

(Passed) (A) Consider approval to add a NYSPHSAA SAAC student to all select NYSPHSAA Standing Committees as determined by the NYSPHSAA Executive Director. (Amended motion)

(Passed) (A) Consider approval of revisions to the Hall of Fame Policies and Operating Procedures.

(Passed) (A) Consider approval of waivers of the Representation Rule for various sections.

(Passed) (A) Consider approval of Friend & Neighbor and new member schools.

(Passed) (A) Consider approval of sections intent to participate in the 2024-2025 NYSPHSAA State Championships.

(Passed) (A) Consider approval to allow NYSPHSAA member Football programs to start practice on the Wednesday Monday of Week #7 for Fall 2024. (Amended motion)

(Passed) (A) Consider approval to modify combined practice requirement in the sport of Football - "F. 11-man football may conduct 11-on-11 drills for a maximum of 10 offensive and 10 defensive plays and 8-man football may conduct 8-on-8 drills for a maximum of 10 offensive plays and 10 defensive plays."

(Passed) (A) Consider approval to adopt a three-day, bracketed tournament, starting with the 2024 season in Girls Volleyball.

(Passed) (A) Consider approval of Middletown High School as the host of the NYSPHSAA Boys Soccer Championships (2025-2027).

(Passed) (A) Consider approval to permit the use of rotating at-large berths when a Division (1, 2 or Composite) has an odd number of teams competing in the NYSPHSAA Bowling Championships. (Amended motion to remove: "The schedule will consist of sections who have ten (10) or more competing schools for each of the respective divisions.")

(Passed) (A) Consider approval to allow bowlers to compete in both the team and composite state tournament events at section discretion.

(Passed) (A) Consider approval for a permanent waiver of the Representation Rule reducing the minimum number of races from six (6) to three (3) in the sport of Skiing.

(Passed) (A) Consider approval of Clarence High School (2025) and Whitesboro High School (2026) as the hosts of the NYSPHSAA Gymnastics Championships.

(Passed) (A) Consider approval for Softball to adopt NFHS Rules with waivers beginning in the 2025 season.

(Passed) (A) Consider approval of Boys Lacrosse Classification Cut-off numbers for 2025.
