Timeline:

- November
 - NYSPHSAA to release interest survey via NYSPHSAA news, social media, and direct email to ADs.
- January
 - Sections receive interest survey submissions from NYSPHSAA.
 - Sections select attendees based on interest surveys.
 - Sections begin planning travel.
- February
 - NYSPHSAA to send permission forms (hopefully online) to students/parents
- March
 - NYSPHSAA to provide sections with permission information

Finances:

- NYSPHSAA to cover the cost of student hotel rooms
