## **BOWLING BOYS and GIRLS**

**MATCH VENUE:** Mardi-Bob Lanes 45 Taft Avenue Poughkeepsie, N.Y., and Hoe Bowl on the Hill 644 East Chester St. Kingston, N.Y.

**MATCH TIME:** 3:20 p.m. start practice, 3:30 p.m. start match.

**POSTPONEMENTS:** If one school needs to cancel, we reschedule to the next make-up date. Generally on the following Monday, unless there is no school, then it will be on the next Tuesday.

**SECTIONALS/STATES:** Bowlers must have bowled in 18 games in order to qualify for Sectionals and States.

**AWARDS:** Each school is in charge of their awards for their bowlers.

**GENERAL MATCH FORMAT:** Follow NYSPHSAA and USBC Rules. Ten minutes of practice. One match per day. Three games per match. Five bowlers per game. Three subs per match. All other bowlers are on practice lanes bowling up to three games. Girls team not having the required five bowlers receives a Blind bowler score of 120 per each absent bowler, not to exceed two spots per game. Boys team not having the required five bowlers receives a Blind bowler score of 160 per each absent bowler, not to exceed two spots.

**SECTIONAL MATCH FORMAT:** Ten minutes of practice in the A.M., and P.M. A total of six games bowled. Three in the A.M. Break for lunch. Three in the P.M. Five Bowlers per game. Three subs all day. School team, boys and girls, winning most pins over all six games, go to States as the State Team. From the remaining schools, the top six averages from the season and sectional tournament, girls and boys, go to States as the All-Section Team.

**STATE MATCH REPRESENTATION:** Two Day format. The School team, boys and girls, go to States and compete against the other school teams. This is on a Saturday. The All-Section team competes on Sunday. Awards given out at States, both days are:

- First, Second and Third Place Team
- First, Second and Third Place Individual High Game
- First, Second and Third Place Individual 6 Game High Series
- One boy and One girl from EACH section receives a Sportsmanship T-Shirt from NYSPHSAA
- IF any bowler bowls a 300 there is an award for a perfect game.
