- All-Star teams will have a maximum of 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ minutes for an all music routine.
- Each cheer team will have a maximum of 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ minutes for a cheer/dance routine.
- Each team **MUST** provide a license certificate for their music.
- There will be a sound system provided (bluetooth for mat time available). Please bring two copies of their music.
- Team trophies will be awarded to first, second, and third place teams in each division (subject to change depending on the number of teams within the division).
- Cheer apparel and other items will be available for purchase throughout the competition.
- The cafeteria will be open for breakfast, lunch, snacks, and refreshment items throughout the competition.090
