RATING STANDARDS

Objective:

1. The rating of officials is necessary to rank individuals for possible playoff assignments.
2. The rating of officials is necessary to place officials in their proper level/group.
3. To improve the performance of the official being rated.

Rating:

- The rating scale is a single numerical statement of how you saw the athletic contest officiated. The rater should take the time to evaluate the entire game to ensure consistency and objectivity. The rating scale is 1-9.
 - Superior – 9-8
 - Above Average – 7-6
 - Average – 5-4
 - Below Average – 3-2
 - Poor – 1
- Judgment is the most subjective criteria and **should not be** based on one call in a game situation.

Criteria:

1. Performance (game conditions)
 - a. Mechanics – as per sport standard
 - b. Game Control
 - c. Consistency
 - d. Attitude
 - e. Judgment
2. Knowledge of the rules
3. Appearance
