Chapter Reports:

Weather Related:

Storm damage ranged from practice/playfields being wiped out to games just being relocated or rescheduled. Each chapter experienced heavy rescheduling issues.

Budget:

It is business as usual in Nassau County with no teams or levels being lost to budgetary concerns. All other sections lost games, teams, or programs due to new budgetary constraints. There are concerns within leagues with schools dropping various levels of programs which have a greater impact than a uniform dropping of a level.

Selection Classification:

Rumor has it that the Presidential Fitness Test will be used to "classify" seventh and eighth graders. The State Edu. Department is looking to not have a waiver option in the SC Program. A successful candidate would have to be in the 90th percentile in all categories no appeals.

Transfer Rule:

There is an effort afoot to have the transfer rule apply to seventh and eighth graders.

Conference Awards:

Scott Sugar gave kudos to the Chapter Awards Chairs, as all required information was submitted in a timely fashion. He has simplified the process by creating fill-in forms that the award chairs complete on-line. He is looking for the same level of commitment this year for the information to be completed on time.
