Weather Related:

Selection Classification:

Rumor has it that the Presidential Fitness Test will be used to "classify" seventh and eighth graders. The State Edu. Department is looking to not have a waver option in the SC Program. A successful candidate would have to be in the 90th percentile in all categories no appeals.

Transfer Rule:

There is an effort afoot to have the transfer rule apply to seventh and eighth graders.
