### Tournament Structure (all games up to finals)

1. Quarter finals and Semi finals will be played at the higher seed home court.
2. Finals will be played at a neutral site determined by the committee.
3. The host school will furnish announcer, scorekeeper, Libero tracking person, ticket taker, security and any other necessary personnel to secure safe environment.
4. Traveling team will assume bus responsibility.
5. Visiting school will send chaperones.
6. Protest procedure: see attached sheet.

### Team Selections

1. 500 or better conference/division/league record.
2. 500 or better overall class record.
3. 500 or better class conference/division record.
4. Plus points in conference/division.
5. Overall plus points.
6. Committee selection with written justification.

### Seeding

All teams will be seeded by dividing the number of division/conference games into total number of conference/division points.

Seeding for AA will be done by dividing number of division games into number of division points. In class AA, seeding will be done according to OCIAA record over all Division I and Division II records.

### Tie Breaker

1. Head to head (including tie breaker)
2. Overall total points divided by overall games
3. In order of seeding how they do with other/common teams
4. If two teams are tied, coin flip will determine

Roster submissions

## SECTION IX TOURNAMENT SEEDING MODIFICATION

### GAME PROCEDURES

1. Opening ceremonies
2. All volleyball games are to be played according to 2009 NCAA rules.
3. At the **FINALS**, a scorer, libero tracker and announcer will be furnished by Section IX.
4. Winning schools are responsible for notifying the media of the results. All three newspapers must be notified:  
Times Herald Record (845) 295-2181  
Poughkeepsie Journal (845) 437-4845  
Kingston Freeman (845) 331-5000
5. Home schools are responsible for providing the following for **quarterfinals and semi finals**:
  - Providing warm up balls for both teams
  - Providing legal game balls (TachiKara Gold, TachiKara SV5W, Spaulding Topflite, Molton Supertouch)
  - Providing an official scorer, announcer and libero tracker
  - Providing chaperones
  - Assuring net is set up at least 30 minutes prior to game start

### GAME OFFICIALS

Will be assigned by Section IX Committee in conjunction with the assigner.

### TICKETS

1. Ticket prices at the door will be as follows:

Sectional finals	Adults \$6.00 per person	Students \$4.00
Regional semis	\$7.00 per person	Students \$5.00

2. Section IX passes will not be honored throughout the tournament.
3. Athletic Directors will fax game gate list to Toni Woody at 256-4154 no later than 48 hours before finals or regionals. (see form)
4. All expenses incurred by the Volleyball Committee will be underwritten by Section IX.
5. Each school is permitted 20 gate list guests. When the number of guests exceeds the gate list total or 20 the school will be billed. Parents of players may not be on the gate list

## **Entry Deadline**

Entries must be received by **Tuesday, October 27, 2009**

Your cards must be in the hands of a chairperson by October 27, 2009 in order to be seeded. Only teams that have submitted cards will be considered. If you do not have all your league games completed by October 23, 2009 the committee will seed you based on your card.

Final game(s) will be filled in by the chairperson of the respective leagues.

**\*\*Committee will determine all sites for finals and regionals\*\***

- Time and site subject to change
- Game balls will be provided for finals and regionals only
- 22 minute warm-up for finals only (See following page.)
- **Teams must provide their own practice balls for finals and regionals.**

## **Awards**

1. Plaques—A championship and runner-up plaque will be awarded in each class.
2. Shield—NYS Athletic Shields will be awarded to members of the five tournament winners (maximum of 16 per school.)
3. T-shirts – maximum of 16 per school.

## **Supervision and Game Control**

All participating schools shall be required to send the appropriate number of school personnel to supervise the spectator's actions. Serious violations of good sportsmanship may lead to the individual(s) being suspended from all further games.

**All supervisors/chaperones of tournament teams will report to the score table before the match and are required to wear an armband or identifying jacket.**

## **Other**

Tournament teams are not permitted to practice at neutral sites assigned for tournament games once the regular season has concluded.

## Standard Operational Procedures

The official pre match protocol for Regionals and up for season championships is shown below. It is recommended that this protocol be used during Sectional play.

Official warm up is 22 minutes.

10 minutes together, 6 minutes serving team, 6 minutes receiving team.

Match Begins

The official post match “Awards Ceremony” should consist of: Team members line up on 10’ line. Award and announce the Runner-up team and present certificates and trophy (if one is to be given) and then award and announce the Championship team and present certificates and trophy.

## Protest Procedure for Sectionals, Regionals and Finals

1. No protest based on officials’ judgments will be heard by the committee.
2. The protest committee will be composed of the three members of the Volleyball Committee.
3. Any coach lodging a protest will immediately notify one of the game officials that he or she is playing the game under protest and follow the following procedure:
  - A. The protesting coach will write a complete statement outlining the reasons for the protest. The written protest should be submitted to a member of the Volleyball Committee. If no committee member is present, the officials are to accept the protest and notify the Chairman immediately. The officials and Chairman (if available) will rule on the protest immediately.
4. The Protest Committee’s decision will be final in all instances.

## SEEDING MODIFICATION WORKSHEET INSTRUCTIONS

There are two situations where the modification could apply:

1. Type 1 – A larger school with more than 50 % their of division games against smaller schools.
2. Type 2 – A smaller school with more than 50 % their of division games against larger schools.

For each of these schools determine:

- a. Total number of games played
- b. Total number of non-league games played
- c. Number of games against opponents of the same class
- d. Number of non-league games against opponents of the same class

For Type 1 determine if they meet either the criteria:

- Is the number of games against opponents of the same class divided by total number of games played  $\geq 25\%$ ?
- Is the number of non-league games against opponents of the same class divided by total number of non-league games played  $\geq 50\%$ ?
- If yes, these games are included in determining the seed.
- If no, the team cannot be seeded higher than 5<sup>th</sup>.

For Type 2 only include the non-league games if they improve their points/games number.

**Rationale:** If a team is competing in a Class “X” Sectional Tournament their seed should be determined by including a certain number of games against Class “X” opponents.

**Part I** – If more than 50 % of the division games used to determine the seed of a team are against schools of a **smaller** class the following rules will apply:

1. The team must meet either criteria a or b:
  - a. A minimum of 25 % of their total games must be played against teams that are in their own class.
  - b. A minimum of 50 % of their non-league\* games must be played against teams that are in their own class.  
\* These are games that are not mandated by the league.
2. If a team meets either criterion, the games against teams that are in their own class are included in the games used for seeding.
3. If a team does not meet either criterion their seed is adjusted so it is no higher than #5.

**Part II** – If more than 50 % of the division games used to determine the seed of a team are against schools of a **larger** class, the use of **non-division games** against teams that are in the same class is **optional**, no minimums apply, and will only be used if it improves their points/games

**Note:**

- This effects only the seeding, not the qualification process.
