## Subject: School Health Examinations in Light of COVID-19 Pandemic

In the May 21, 2020 New York State Education Department memo School Health Examinations in Light of COVID-19 Pandemic, the Department asked schools to continue to accept any physical examination form from students for physicals conducted on or before January 30, 2021, regardless of the form used; allowed parents/guardians additional time to obtain a health exam for school attendance, and allowed students to participate in fall interscholastic athletics if they met the requirements in the memo. In light of the current status of the COVID-19 pandemic, the Department is again extending the requirements for a health exam for school attendance and participation in interscholastic athletics. Schools should:

- Allow additional time for parents/guardians to obtain a health examination from a private healthcare provider before scheduling an appraisal with the director of school health services (medical director) if private healthcare providers are unavailable due to the COVID crisis. We encourage schools not to schedule grade level health appraisals with their medical director until April 2021, although that may change depending on the status of the COVID-19 pandemic in the spring; and
- Permit student athletes to participate in the 2020-2021 sports seasons if they have previously had a health examination for school attendance in the 2018-2019 or 2019-2020 school years and provide a current health history completed and signed by their parent/guardian within 30 days of the start of the season, unless a current health examination is deemed necessary by the school district's director of school health services (medical director). Schools should use the revised Interval Health History for Athletics form which includes questions on COVID-19. The Department will provide updated information as needed.
- Please note Beginning January 31, 2021 physical examinations for school are to be documented on the <a href="NYS Required Health Examination Form">NYS Required Health Examination Form</a> or an electronic health record equivalent form. The <a href="Instructions for Completion of New York State School Health Examination Form">Instructions for Completion of New York State School Health Examination Form</a> provides direction to healthcare providers on the details of the required components and the required presentation order of those components for an electronic health record form to be an equivalent form. Both of these documents are available on <a href="NYSED's School Health Services Webpage">NYSED's School Health Services Webpage</a>.

Classification cutoff numbers 2021 for soccer, basketball, baseball, softball

### **Addressing the Sectional Concern:**

- 1) Freeze the 2021 cut-off numbers in the sports of Baseball, Softball, Soccer, and Basketball for two (2) years (therefore, you would be using the 2020-2021 numbers).
- 2) Convene a NYSPHSAA Committee to review the data of the Combining of Teams so that the accurate number of teams, not schools, are used in the classification cut-off numbers.

#### Rationale:

Dropping AA from 965 to 800 is too drastic a change. We need to look at combining of teams, differential numbers within each class, and the current enrollment trends to determine an equitable distribution of schools within in each class. Just dividing our schools into 20% groups no longer works in our opinion.

Since state ed is not providing the BEDS numbers until September is also problematic. This means NYSPHSAA presents the 20% breakdown for discussion in October to be voted on in February and then implementation for September. In Section IX we have most of our fall schedules in place by February. It is time for us to think differently.

Once a venue has been selected, the sport committee will be informed and the CAC will provide feedback before Central/Executive Committee approval. If the staff is unsuccessful, revisions will be made to the terms of the RFP and it will be redistributed as a new bid.


While the recent issues are likely due in part to COVID-19, we will be taking a more proactive approach with bids moving forward. If we do not receive submissions for a particular bid, the committee will convene to discuss potential issues with the RFP. ### Proposal:

Consideration of approval to eliminate "or a private school within that district's boundaries" from the NYSPHSAA Transfer Rule. See below.

31.b. A student who transfers without a corresponding change in residence of his/her parents (or other persons with whom the student has resided for at least six months prior) is ineligible to participate at the varsity level in any interscholastic athletic contest in a particular sport for a period of one (1) year if as a 9-12 student participated in that sport during the one (1) year period immediately preceding his/her transfer. A student's period of ineligibility begins with the date of registration at the student's new school. (May 2020) NOTE: Students in grades 7-10, shall be eligible to participate at the sub-varsity level and practice at all levels, while students in grades 11-12 shall be limited to practice (all levels) only. (July 2019). At no time during the one-year period of ineligibility at the varsity level should a student participate in a scrimmage or be an exhibition participant at the varsity level.

Students who transfer from any school to the public-school district of the residence of his/her parents (or other persons whom the student has resided for at least six months) or a private school within that district's boundaries shall receive a waiver from the Transfer Rule. Such a transfer without penalty will only be permitted once in a high school career. Schools must submit the required transfer form to the Section office. Athletes are not permitted to practice before the form has been submitted. Athletes are not permitted to compete without approval. NOTE: A student in a foreign exchange program listed by CSIET has a one-year waiver of the Transfer Rule. If such a student elects to stay a second year he/she becomes a foreign student at the start of the school year with item (b) in effect.

### **Effective Start Date:**

2021-2022 School Year

#### Rationale:

The verbiage creates an unfair advantage for the private school of transfer and public schools without a private school within their boundaries. All other transfers from a public school district to a private school are subject to the transfer rule in any sport a student participated in for one (1) year. As a result of the current language, students can transfer to a private school within their district's boundaries for athletic purposes for no penalty. This only impacts districts with private school within their boundary and it should be consistent across the state regardless of the location of the private school.

## BASEBALL – ELIMINATE NYSPHSAA P/DH RULE; UTILIZE NFHS P/DH RULE

Proposal: The NYSPHSAA Baseball Committee seeks approval to eliminate the NYSPHSAA Pitcher/Designated Hitter Rule (#11 in NYSPHSAA Handbook) and utilize the NFHS Player/Designated Hitter Rule.
Effective Start Date: March 2021
Rationale: This proposal will eliminate the more restrictive NYSPHSAA Pitcher/Designated Hitter Rule, adopted in January 2019, and allow teams to use a more flexible NFHS Rule which was written following the 2019 season. The NFHS Rule allows the pitcher to play any other defensive position whereas the NYSPHSAA Rule does not allow that.
Proposal Originated:  NYSPHSAA Baseball Committee on June 8, 2018. The NYSPHSAA P/DH Rule was approved in January 2019 and adopted for the 2019 season. The NFHS Rule was written after the 2019 season.

## **Baseball Rules Changes**

NOTE: Due to the cancellation of spring sports last year because of the Coronavirus, the 2020 NFHS Baseball Rules will be used for the 2021 season. The Rules Changes written last year will apply for the 2021 season. These changes, which all reference the 2020 NFHS Baseball Rules Book, will be in effect for the 2021 season.

3-1-4: Designated Hitter (DH) can be used in two ways. The DH can be listed as the tenth starter replacing one of the other nine players when it is their turn to bat. The other method is that that any one of the starting defensive players can be their own DH (in effect having two positions) within the confines of the rule requirements.

Rationale: This rule change assists coaches with an alternative to keep their better players in the game to contribute to the offensive output of the team and give another player a chance to participate on defense. In addition, considering the pitch count rules, this change would help pitchers to keep their bat in the game, but can come out of the game defensively to protect their arms from overuse.

The culminating Gymnastics event took place on February 20th, 2021 at Ziggys Gymnastics Academy in Middletown. The meet was run as close as I could to that of a Sectional Event. We were fortunate enough to have the event live streamed on Zoom so that all of our athlete's families and friends were able to watch due to the no spectator rule. I am forever grateful to Mike Zigrossi, owner of Ziggy's Gymnastics for setting this up for our athletes and allowing us to host our meet at his beautiful facility.

The meet was kicked off by honoring our 4 senior athletes with flowers and introductions of the four teams that participated in Gymnastics this year (Wallkill, FDR, Kingston and New Paltz). 35 athletes participated in Saturday's event and all of the coaches/athletes were happy for the opportunity to have an event similar to what our Sections usually entail.

Athletes were awarded medals and ribbons as well as a team plaque and a plaque for our individual champion. Thank you section 9 for making the athletes smile under those masks!

The competition looked/was ran differently than those of the past. Every gymnast, official and coach that entered the facility was screened by myself. I met each team at their bus and conducted the health screening and took their arrival temperature using the section 9 roster form that each coach supplied me with.

The meet took longer than expected, for we normally have 8 officials (2 per event) but in recent years we have only had 4 officials (1 per event). For our meet this year we had 2 officials therefore each official had to judge two events so the meet ran longer than usual. I am so fortunate to have worked with Amanda York the past couple years—she is amazing with trying her best

to secure officials for our events, without her I am not sure we would have been able to assign officials to the meet. I am very appreciative of all of her efforts this season for I know it has been difficult, my sincere thanks to Amanda! I am also extremely grateful for Cheryl Wilson and Jessica Schudenkopf for officiating this meet for our athletes, for without their presence the meet would not have been able to exist. Again, thank you Cheryl and Jessica.

All in all, I feel the meet was a success. In terms of protocols/policies- Chairs for the athletes were spaced 6 feet apart, we put lines on the vault run way that we're 6 feet apart for gymnasts to wait their turn, hand sanitizer was located at each event and I met with each team before the event to go over this information as well as stating that masks be worn at all times by all individuals. I was met with some resistance when stating everyone must wear a mask at all times. Some coaches expressed that they let their gymnastics pull it down before competing. The USA Gymnastics rules are different than those of our section rules which state,

"Athletes: require all athletes/students wear masks or facial coverings while entering the facility. Once arriving at their initial physically-distanced station, the athlete can then remove the mask or facial coverings, place it into a paper/plastic bag, and keep it isolated with their personal items throughout the competition. The mask or facial coverings should be worn while using other areas of the facility (i.e. bathrooms), and while exiting the facility after competition"

I reiterated that we follow the Sections rules, not USAG. I sent out many emails in preparation for the culminating event as well as emails when we were given the green light for gymnastics to even compete this year. I emailed the section protocols and rules and reiterated safety precautions so I was a little shocked by some of the reactions regarding masks. For the most part, athletes followed the mask policy but there were occasions where a gymnast, once she presented to the judge, pulled her mask down or before a difficult move on the balance beam, mid routine, pulled it down. I addressed this with the coaches again during the meet. Even after addressing the mask rule with the coach I witnessed it happening again.

Moving forward, if required to still wear masks, I see this being the only problem. As I mentioned I addressed it weeks prior, to each team individually, before the meet and during but still seemed to have an issue.

I would also like to thank Section 9 for all of their hard-work with getting our athletes back into play safely. Without all of your work our season was able to exist and for that I, and I will speak for the athletes, are forever grateful.
